Gentlemen:-

I beg to submit for your consideration my report upon the work of The Ottawa Improvement Commission, during the Fiscal year terminating on the 31st March 1913, under the following headings, namely:-

1. Statement in detail of the Expenditure upon New Work.
2. Statement in detail of the cost of Maintenance of the various Parks and Driveways, for the year.
3. Detailed statement of all other expenditures.
4. Statement in detail of the number, variety and location of Bedding Plants and bulbs planted during the year.

You will observe in Statement "B" that the appropriation for Strathcona Park and Patterson's Creek Parks has been exceeded. At Strathcona Park part of the terrace broke down and this was repaired and a concrete tool house built into the bank for the accommodation of the workmen in the park.

At Patterson's Creek, west of Bank street, owing to the filling in of the lands west of the Commission's property, the surface water was forced into and flooded the park, necessitating the construction of a series of tile drains with outlet on Roseberry Avenue.

Neither of those works were anticipated in the estimates.

- : LADY GREY ROAD :-

Work on the "Lady Grey Road" was commenced in June 1911 and prosecuted continuously since. During the year ending 31st. March 1912 the sum of \$49,363.83 was spent of which details are given in my last report. During the current year there was expended \$2,613.65, with which sum the stone retaining wall was completed and surmounted with a granolithic sidewalk with curb along the outer edge on which is erected a three strand iron pipe fence, forming part of which are 27 three-light lamp standards. A large amount of filling was deposited, drains gutters and curb constructed and the roadway prepared for the finishing coats of macadam. The roadway from Sussex street to Lady Grey Road at the Queen's Cart was macadamised and treated with Reseams and on the western side a two strand iron pipe fence was erected. Leading from Sussex street to Lady Grey Road a concrete stairs and from Lady Grey Road to the lower level a wooden stairs were erected, the former being protected on either side by an iron pipe fence. At the base of the rocky bluff vines were planted. Details of the expenditure are as follows:-

During the year, Princess Avenue and Lisgar Road, extending from Riverside Terrace immediately in the rear of Rideau Hall Grounds to the junction of Lisgar Road and Park road was covered with 6,825 square yards of Macadam after being graded and then thoroughly rolled at a cost of \$3,101.07, details of which are as follows:-

"McDonald Gardens"

Negotiations having been concluded and the "Old Cemeteries" having been transferred by lease from the Corporation of the City of Ottawa to the Commission and the plan for the improvement of same, prepared by Mr. F.G.Todd, having been accepted, work upon the McDonald Gardens was commenced towards the close of the season. A large amount of filling was deposited and most of the grading done. The expenditure during the year was \$2,849.84, of which the following are the details:-

"Dow's Lake Causeway"

The action of the water having washed away some of the filling from under the Causeway and caused the sidewalk to sink in several places, it was deemed advisable to prevent further sinkage by depositing in the lake along the walls of the Causeway, rock filling from the shores of the lake and hardpan from the lands acquired from Mr. L.R.O'Connell. The cost of this work, to the end of the fiscal year, was \$6,051.87 of which the following are the details:-

- :National Park roadway:-

The crib work retaining wall on the roadway at the entrance to National Park having given away it became necessary to make permanent repairs and a special appropriation was obtained therefor. The roadway was dug out to the solid rock and a concrete retaining wall was erected thereon. The rock bluff on the hill side was blasted out for the purpose of widening the road and the portion excavated was refilled, graded and macadamized and the walk and fence rebuilt. The cost of this work was \$7,458.94, details of which are as follows:-

REPORT OF THE OTTAWA IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED MARCH 31ST. 1913.

As required by Section 11 of 62-63 Victoria,
Chapter 10 as amended by Section 3 of 4-5 Edward VII Chapter 29.
being an Act respecting the city of Ottawa, the Ottawa Improve-
ment Commission has the honour to report as follows.

During the fiscal year which closed on March 31,
1913, the revenue at the disposal of the Commission amounted
to \$151,246.81. derived from the following sources,-

Annual Statutory Grant \$100,000.00

Balance from sale of hotel site.

Major's Hill Park 33,225.00

Miscellaneous, rent, sales &c. 888.68

Balance carried forward from 1911-12 17,133.23

The expenditure during the same period amounted
to \$145,532.27. of this total amount \$71,632.23 was expended
on new works, that is, on works other than ordinary maintenance.

THE OTTAWA IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION

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A statement in detail of this expenditure will be found in the attached report of the Superintendent of Works - Mr. Alex Stuart.

The conversion of the site of the old cemetries on Sandy Hill, between Cobourg and Furtenburg Streets, held by the Commission under lease from the city corporation, into a public park, work on which was commenced during last year, has been practically completed during the current fiscal year.

The Commission has named this park Macdonald Gardens after Sir John A. Macdonald, first Prime Minister of the Dominion of Canada.

The recent installation of electric lights by the Public Works Department on Repean Point Park and Lady Grey Road has supplied a much needed want and has added considerably not only to their appearance but to their safety as public resorts.

As originally mapped out the Lady Grey Road extends from the entrance to Major's Hill Park at the Chateau Laurier to Government House Grounds, so that only a portion of the road has been completed.

It will not be possible to make any improvement on that portion of it, at present, better known as Mackenzie

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Avenue, until the Government building, now under course of construction on the Sussex Street property acquired by the Government, has been completed. In the meantime, through the courtesy of the Public Works Department, the road has been extended through Major's Hill Park.

The expenditure on maintenance during the year amounted to £53,445.04 exclusive of £21,455.00 for the redemption of debenture No. 9.

There are yet to be redeemed six of these debentures (No. 10 having been redeemed in July 1913) involving six annual payments of a like amount. (£21,455.00)

The expenditure for maintenance as well as for new works will be found in Mr. Stuart's report and in a different form in the report of the Auditor General of Canada for the fiscal year 1912-13 on page P. 34.

During the coming fiscal year commencing April 1st. 1914, the Commission will have at its disposal to meet all expenditures, only the annual statutory grant of £100,000.00. The ordinary maintenance of the parks and driveways at present under its control will absorb about £55,000.00 of this amount and the redemption of the debenture debt, £21,455.00, leaving only some £23,000.00 for new works and unforeseen expenses.

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THE OTTAWA IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION

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It will not be possible therefore, to undertake any new works next year with the means at the disposal of the Commission under existing statutory enactment.

There are many new works which the Commission deem necessary to the completion of the present driveways.

(1) The continuation of the Rideau Canal driveway through the Exhibition Grounds thus connecting with the driveway west of Bank Street and making a continuous drive along the Canal bank from the Experimental Farm to Laurier Avenue.

(2) Construction of a concrete protection wall on the north and west side of the Rideau Canal from Dow's Lake to Laurier Bridge. This protection wall, the Commission considers a necessity, not only as a protection to the public using the driveway, but as a means of preserving navigation on the Canal.

(3) An efficient lighting system on the driveway from the Experimental Farm to Laurier Bridge, all of which is on ordnance land.

(4) The Commission has applied for the transfer of the ordnance land on the east and south side of the Canal and should this application be granted much needed improvements will have to be undertaken.

THE OTTAWA IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION

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A sketch and estimate of the work so much needed in connection with the Rideau Canal driveway are appended herewith. This estimated expenditure does not include \$49,683.30 for the portion of the driveway through the Exhibition grounds, particulars of which were given under date October 7, 1913.
