FISCAL YEAR ENDED MARCH, 31, 1916.

In accordance with the provisions of the statute, 62-63 Vict. Chap. 10 and the amending statute 4-5 Edward VII Chap. 29 being Acts respecting the city of Ottawa, the Ottawa Improvement Commission has the honour to report as follows:

During the fiscal year which terminated on March 31, 1916 the total funds at the disposal of the Commission amounted to \$111,731.34 derived from the following sources:-

The expenditure during the same period amounted to \$104,096.80. Statements in detail of this expenditure will be found in the attached report submitted to the Commission by Mr. A. Stuart, superintendent of works.

The system of electric lighting installed on the parks and driveways under the Commission's control at a cost of \$26,664.68 was the only new work undertaken and completed during the year.

The installation of this much needed lighting system has been accomplished at a figure considerably below the first estimates prepared by the superintendent of works. The reduction in cost has been effected by the adoption of specially designed re-inforced concrete lamp posts instead of the old style cast iron posts and the elimination of concrete covered conduits, upon the cost of which the first estimates were based.

These concrete posts were adopted by the Commission on the recommendation of Mr. Stuart, under whose supervision the necessary moulds were made, and the posts cast at the Commission's

workshop at Rockcliffe at a cost far below the price the Commission would be obliged to pay for iron posts.

Apart from the cost, though an important consideration, the Board of Commissioners was of one mind in the selection of the concrete posts as more suitable to the driveways and parks than the old style iron posts, as they will not need painting, are fully as durable and as to ornamentation they will be improved rather than impaired by age and climatic conditions.

The electric current is supplied by the Ottawa Hydro-Electric Commission from the Ottawa Municipal plant free of cost to the Improvement Commission, so that the only cost of maintenance will be lamp and globe renewals and supervision.

The total cost of maintenance of the various parks and driveways last year, including the annual payment of \$21,455 for the redemption of the debenture debt was \$75,296.96 and as it is unlikely that this amount can be reduced in the future, less than \$25,000 of the statutory grant will be available for new work and unforeseen expenditure.

There are at present date three annual payments on debenture debt still due amounting to \$64,365.

The statutory grant of \$100,000 per annum will lapse with the payment of the quarterly instalment due on April 1, 1919.

During the year a system of Electric Lighting was installed on The Rideau Canal Driveway, extending from the Causeway at Dow's Lake to the corner of Elgin Street and Laurier Avenue, ( excepting that portion lying between Patterson and Argyle Avenues and the portion lying within the grounds of the Central Canada Exhibition Association) Clemow Avenue from Bronson Avenue to O'Connor; Monkland Avenue and Linden Terrace from O'Connor Street to the Rideau Canal Driveway: Central and Strathcona Parks. Concrete lamp standards of our own make were used for this purpose. Along the roadways they were placed about one hundred feet apart and staggered alternately on either side. On the top of the standards were placed cast iron combination lamp and globe holders and the lamp sockets were connected to wire running through the centre of the standards to the ground and those wires were connected with an underground paper insulated lead covered double steel tape armoured cable through which is received the Electric current supplied by The Ottawa Hydro-Electric Commission service.

At the request of The Rideau Canal Branch of The Department of Railways and Canals, Echo Drive, from the C.P.R. bridge to Hartwell's Locks, was graded and macadamized, part of the retaining wall was ~~rebuilt~~ repaired and a portion built. The cost of this work was refunded by the Department, the expenditure being as follows:-

The ordinary maintenance consists of the keeping of roadways, walks, paths &c. clear of mud and refuse; cutting and watering grass on boulevards; caring for and trimming trees and shrubs as well as replacing dead trees and shrubs in Spring and Autumn and the cost of materials, tools and machinery.

Extraneous Maintenance consists of the cost of renewal of roadways, walks, curbs, gutters, water services and repairs to bridges, cribwork, iron fences &c.
