The Ottawa Improvement Commission, as required by the Statute
9-10 George V Chapter 62 Section 13, has the honour to submit the
following report for the fiscal year ended March 31st 1924.

The gross revenue at the Commission's disposal during the year was Rs 202,799.74 derived from the following sources:-

The expenditure during the same period amounted to the sum of ₦180,701.93. Appended hereto is a report prepared by the Superintendent of Works and the Secretary showing the details of this expenditure. Included in this expenditure is the sum of ₦18,364.37 which represents the cost of work done for the Government and other parties which amount has been rebated to the Commission by the parties for whom the work was performed.

On maintenance, including the cost of administration there was expended the sum of \$101,273.42 and on new work \$79,468.51 including the \$18,364.37.

During the year the Western Driveway, from Carling Avenue to the Canadian National Railway tracks was completed thus making a continuous Driveway from Carling Avenue to the Ottawa River. In addition, with the permission of the Department of Public Works, Princess Avenue in Rockcliffe was widened thus adding to the safety of travel there. A walk was constructed over the gully near Elshbury and a lookout erected overlooking the Gatineau River. The wall along the Rideau River in King Edward Avenue park was strengthened and an iron pipe fence erected thereon. On Rideau Canal Driveway a combined Comfort Station and Tool House was erected while additions were made to the lighting system.

During the year there was little variation in the cost of labour and materials used.

-: Widening Princess Avenue :-

As traffic was compelled to cross the Ottawa Electric Railway tracks at the foot of the hill entering Rockliffe Park creating a dangerous condition, the Department of Public Works granted to the Commission a licence of occupation of a portion of the Rideau Hall grounds, that a roadway might be provided and in necessity avoided of crossing the tracks. The work was carried out at a cost of \$ 1,858.82, detailed as follows : -

-: Walk over gulley Rockliffe Park :-

It was deemed advisable to provide for public convenience along the Rideau Canal Driveway by the erection of a joint comfort station and tool house in the vicinity of Patterson's Creek.
